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Dowsing for Feng Shui and Space Clearing – finding the living force
by Susan Collins

There is some considerable overlap between Feng Shui and dowzers who specialise in house healing work, with some dowzers utilising Feng Shui techniques and vice versa, yet there is little instructional literature that addresses the needs of both camps – until now.

This new book from Susan is aimed mainly at Feng-Shui practitioners who wish to incorporate dowsing into their practice, and to a lesser extent at dowzers who would like to understand more about the space-clearing methods of Feng-Shui. Much of the dowsing instruction will be familiar to readers of Susan's previous books. Of course, no one book can hope to provide more than an overview of each discipline, but it is the combination view of this workbook that makes it worthwhile addition to the library.

Part One covers the dowsing basics and includes Susan's well-known 'dowsing protocol'. Part Two provides an overview of the various schools of Feng-Shui and includes charts for dowsing the five elements, the hexagrams of the I Ching, and the Bagua. Part Three discusses space-clearing techniques and remedies, and includes Susan's extensive system of triage protocols, here expanded to incorporate the various environmental concepts of Feng-Shui.

Informative, clearly written and packed with helpful protocols, exercises and charts, this is the perfect workbook to bridge the two modalities of dowsing and Feng-Shui, and application of the techniques within will prove of benefit to practitioners of either discipline.
